SERVICES REQUESTED:

_____ **Coached Supervised Visitation:** Provides children and their visiting parent(s) an opportunity to spend time together under the supported observation of a trained Parent Coach. Visiting parents receive a pre-visit and post-visit coaching session where personalized lesson plans provide parents Nurturing Parenting skills. These sessions include goal setting and reflective time to discuss progress towards goals. Enrolled parents have access to weekly Nurturing Parenting classes that reinforce positive parenting skills. Service are free to DFCS families with children in child dependency care and available to private clients on a sliding scale fee schedule. (2-hour total appointment time)

_____ **Monitored Visitation:** Provides children and their visiting parent(s) an opportunity to spend time together under the observation of a trained Child Advocate where client’s emotional and physical safety are monitored, and as necessary, intervention and redirection are provided. Services are available to private clients on a sliding fee schedule. (1-hour appointment time)

_____ **Transitional Visitation:** Allows children and their visiting parent(s) an opportunity to visit without constant supervision; Child Advocates are available for assistance as needed. Arrival and departure times are supervised and documented, but there are no visit observation notes. Services are available to private clients on a sliding fee schedule. (1-hour appointment time)

_____ **Neutral Exchanges:** For purposes of joint custody situations, Child Advocates supervise the on-site exchange of children between custodial and non-custodial parents, ensuring no contact between parents. Services are available to private clients on a sliding fee schedule. (15-minute appointment time)
